ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Austin, Texas March 23, 2018

The Twenty-fourth Annual Meeting of the Members of the Texas Automobile Insurance Plan Association was held at the Austin Omni Hotel Southpark, beginning at 8:35 AM, Friday, March 23, 2018.

The meeting was called to order by Governing Committee Chair, Bill Brooks. Mr. Brooks asked the Association Manager, Stacy Dutton, if a quorum was present. Stacy Dutton stated that a quorum was present. Chair Brooks requested that the Anti-Trust Statement be read. The Association Manager, Stacy Dutton read the statement.

Chair Brooks asked the Association Manager to report on the selection of the trade association representatives, as prescribed in Section 36.B.1. of the TAIPA Plan of Operation. The Association Manager stated that the trade association representatives selected were:

- American Insurance Association (AIA) The Travelers,
- Property & Casualty Insurers Association (PCI) Hochheim Prairie Insurance Company, and
- Association of Fire & Casualty Companies in Texas (AFACT)-Texas Farm Bureau Casualty Insurance Company.

Chair Brooks asked the Association Manager to report the results of the Non-Affiliated insurers' ballot. Ms. Dutton stated that the Non-Affiliated member elected was Allstate Insurance Company.

In keeping with Section 36.B.3, Chair Brooks, announced the four companies that had requested to serve in one of the four at-large positions on the committee. Those companies were:

- Safeco/Liberty Mutual Insurance Company,
- State Farm Mutual Insurance Company and
- United Services Automobile Association (USAA).

Chair Brooks asked if there were any write-in candidates. Stacy Dutton indicated that there were not any write-in candidates. Chair Brooks stated that since there were only four candidates for four open positions that he would like to call for their election by acclamation. A motion was made to accept the slate of candidates presented, it was seconded. A vote was taken on whether to approve the recommendation of accepting the atlarge candidates. All present affirmed that they would like to accept the candidates as presented, no one voted no and no one abstained.

Since there were no votes to be counted, a break was not taken.

ASSOCIATION MANAGER'S REPORT

Texas Automobile Insurance Plan Association (TAIPA) Annual Meeting - March 23, 2018

The following are the number of applications TAIPA assigned in 2017, 2016, 2015, and 2014:

2017	3,508	(3170 private passenger applications and 338 commercial)
2016	3,089	
2015	3,217	
2014	3,628	

The number of applications received in 2017 was 419 more than assigned in 2016, a 13.56% increase.

The TAIPA budget for 2018 is \$846,800 which is \$164,400 less than the 2017 TAIPA budget of \$1,011,200. This is a 16.26% decrease.

The TAIPA assessment to the insurance companies for 2018 is \$825,000 which is \$170,900 less than the 2017 assessments. This is a 17.16% decrease.

A rate change to TAIPA rates for both private passenger and commercial rates were approved in 2016 to be effective February 1, 2017.

The commissioner ordered that TAIPA revise its rates to be charged for private passenger automobile insurance by coverage, territory, and class by:

- Plus 4.8 percent for bodily injury liability
- Plus 4.9 percent for property damage liability
- Plus 4.3 percent for personal injury protection
- Plus 4.3 percent for uninsured/underinsured motorist bodily injury liability
- Plus 4.2 percent for uninsured/underinsured motorist property damage liability

The commissioner ordered that TAIPA revise its rates to be charged for commercial automobile insurance policies by coverage, territory, and vehicle type by:

- Plus 2.1 percent for bodily injury liability,
- Plus 1.1 percent for property damage liability,
- Plus 0.0 percent for personal injury protection,
- No changes to commercial auto uninsured/underinsured motorist bodily injury liability, or uninsured/underinsured motorist property damage liability rates.

TAIPA worked to secure new office space that reduced our space by more than 50% and decreased our office rent by 45% over the term of the lease. TAIPA moved to our new office space on March 17, 2018 and our new address is:

805 Las Cimas Parkway Las Cimas III, Suite 210 Austin, TX 78701 TAIPA upgraded to EASI 2.0 for Commercial Applications on April 11, 2017. The advantages to this upgrade was that producers only need a single login, they can reset their own password, they can retract commercial applications electronically, and there is a single search facility for both private passenger and commercial applications.

TAIPA operated with five (5) full time employees in 2017. TAIPA management worked with the Management Transition Committee and Intelligent Compensation to optimize the organizational structure to better align with actual workloads and ensure total cross training for all positions. Two of the employees elected to take the financial package offered to them in December instead of applying for the new position. In January, we hired a temporary employee to work in the Customer Service Specialist I position and we are still training this employee.

I would like to thank you all for the support and encouragement that Nicole and I received from the TAIPA Governing Committee, the TAIPA officers, and the TAIPA sub-committees as well as TAIPA counsel this year. I would especially like to thank the members of the Management Transition Committee including Bill Brooks, James Rowland, Corise Morrison, Dick Lonquist, Pete Hamel, and the chair, Tom Rolling. We again had to lean on the officers pretty heavily (Dick Lonquist, David Weber, Jim Rowland, and in particular, our Chair, Bill Brooks.) We truly appreciate the extra time and effort everyone put in to help us in 2017. I think it deserves noting that finding time to help us was made even more difficult for some of the Governing Committee after Hurricane Harvey hit and their workloads were greatly increased or they watched it from their back porch.

I'd also like to thank the rest of the TAIPA staff, Mimi Leece, Joyce Boriack, and Wanda Crayton for their work in 2017. I'd especially like to thank Mimi for stepped up to help with the transition taking on all the non-exempt level duties as well as training Quinn in her job duties.

I personally feel indebted to Nicole for her continued diligent efforts to ensure the success of TAIPA particularly in the areas of:

- 1. Accounting/Budgeting
- 2. Operational efficiency
- 3. Planning and Organizing
- 4. Moral Support
- 5. And everything else in between.

Nicole started planning for TAIPA's move in 2017 and it all came to fruition this past week without a hitch. I really can't say enough about Nicole

Through the combined efforts of all of the TAIPA staff, TAIPA continued to provide excellent service to TAIPA applicants, producers, vendors, regulators and members of the TAIPA Governing Committee in 2017.

 - o Mimi Leece moved into the senior level of the two positions.
 - Two employees elected to take financial packages offered instead of applying for either of the new positions.
 - o A temporary employee was hired and is currently working in the entry level position.

While the subcommittee and Governing Committee worked with Stacy and Nicole to develop this plan, provided guidance, etc., it takes management to put all this into place. I want to thank Nicole for her insight and contributions and I especially want to thank Stacy for her excellent leadership in executing the reorganization plan.

I of course would like to thank the members of the Manager Transition Subcommittee for their hard work and dedication to this effort. The committee included Dick Lonquist, who chairs our Strategic Planning Subcommittee where this reorganization effort was initially discussed, Corise Morrison, Pete Hamel, and James Rowland. And the Manager Transition Subcommittee was in the very capable hands of Chairman Tom Rolling. Thank you, Tom.

I also want to thank those who worked diligently on behalf of TAIPA in 2017.
