Addendum to Bulletin 251 and 252

TAIPA recently met with TDI regarding our proposed Plan of Operation change request that is described below. As a result of this meeting, TAIPA has determined that we will handle the Annual Meeting Election differently than was documented in Bulletin 251 and 252.

As a reminder:

- TAIPA did not receive any nominations from the Non-Affiliated companies to fill the non-affiliated position for 2023.
- Therefore, TAIPA has sent a request to change the Plan of Operation to the Texas Department of Insurance to eliminate the non-affiliated position and instead have 5 At Large Representatives starting in 2023.
 - The change includes a clause to encourage at least one of the At Large Representatives to be a Texas domestic insurance company that writes only in the State of Texas and is not an affiliate or a subsidiary of an insurance company or holding company system writing automobile insurance outside of Texas.
 - In the event a Texas domestic insurance company does not apply for the position, the position may be filled with the company that receives the next highest number of votes.
 - *Note that the provision regarding the preference for a Texas Domestic Company was included as we would anticipate a company that only does business in Texas would be smaller and thus more likely to be more similar to the non-affiliated companies.

The Change to the election procedure is highlighted below:

- 1. If the Plan of Operation Change is approved prior to our March 24, 2023 Governing Committee Meeting, the member companies will elect 5 at large members at the Annual Meeting of the Governing Committee.
- 2. If the Plan of Operation Change Request is not approve prior to TAIPA's Annual Meeting, the member companies will elect 4 At-Large Members and the Non-Affiliated position will remain unfilled until a decision is reached on the Plan of Operation Change Request.
